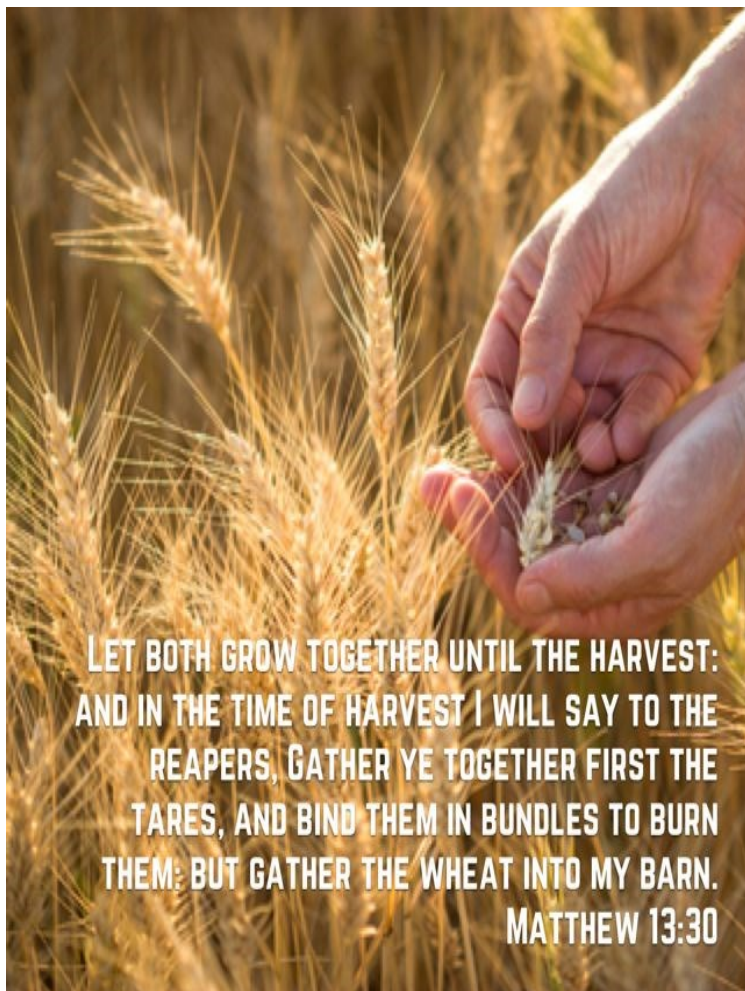

The Latest from the Library



There is a copy of a great book in our Parish Library that we would like to encourage you to look into. It is *The Eight Doors of the Kingdom: Meditations on the Beatitudes* by Jacques Felipe. The author is a member of the Community of the Beatitudes of France. He was ordained a priest in 1985. He primarily devotes himself to spiritual direction and preaching retreats. The Beatitudes, as we have come to know these eight declarations of supreme blessing and spiritual happiness spoken by Jesus in the New Testament, are the true answer to the suffering of the world today. They reveal the face of God made of gentleness, mercy, and humility and propose that the only effective path to human maturity, inner freedom, and peace of heart is to live by them. Fr. Chris Saenz, one of the Columban Fathers that helps us with our Spanish Masses, recommends using the Beatitudes for our Examination of Conscience for confession. We encourage you to try this meditation to assist you in understanding the Beatitudes and how they impact our daily lives.

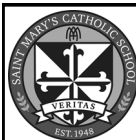
7TH ANNUAL GOLF OUTING

With all the celebrations for our country's 250th anniversary recently, let's celebrate some milestones here at St. Mary's School! In 1981, the first computer - a TRS80 from Radio Shack - was purchased and the school's first yearbook was published. A year later, the band program began. In 1983, the last of the Dominican Sisters left and our Extended Day program began. Remember the old Baker's Store just a block west of the school? In 1986, we partnered with their employees who assisted us with various educational activities. In 1988, Pre-Kindergarten was added. A counselor became part of our staff in 1990 and, a year later, the old convent was renovated for Religious Education programs. Eight classrooms were added along with the teacher's lounge, foreign language was introduced as a subject, and computer education began with Apple 2Es. The old gym was renovated in 1993 to create a computer lab and library. A new multi-purpose gym was built and named the Robert A. Garvey Addition, in honor of pastor Fr. Garvey who had the school built; and St. Mary's could start hosting basketball and volleyball games (the ceiling of the old gym was too low to host home games). In 1994, classrooms got networked computers, and in 1996 Art was added to the curriculum. A storage room by the new gym was renovated in 1998 into a science lab. We were also blessed to have a visiting nurse, teacher's aides, and hot lunch. Finally, in our most recent history, six years ago in 2020 new electrical wiring, fire sprinklers, LED lighting, and HVAC systems were installed.

"The roots continue to gain feeding from the work of teachers, parishioners, parents, community, and alumni, producing fruits of Catholic education continuously ... the efforts, guidance and leadership of many religious and laity, teachers and parents all have provided us with the abundant fruits of Christian education. May God's blessings search out and continue to guide all who contributed to the continuous cycle of life in education through St. Mary's School of Bellevue." (1980 St. Mary's Reunion Booklet)

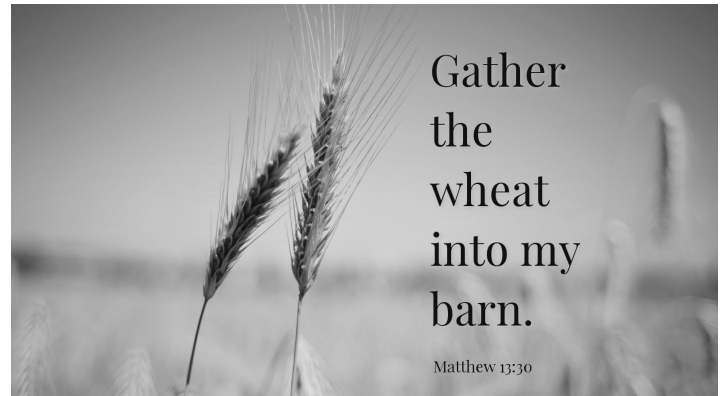
EPS BREAKFAST FOR LIFE

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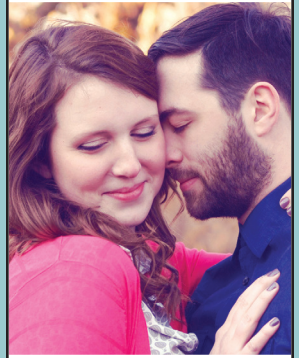
