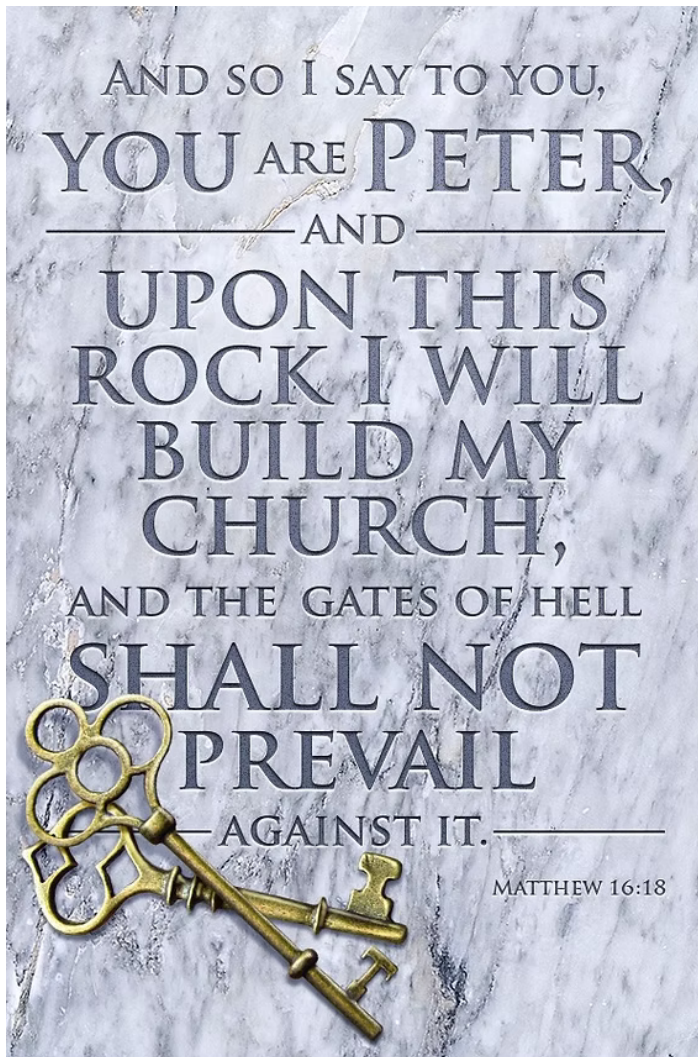

Children ages 4 yrs.-4th grade are invited to go downstairs for their own Gospel message during the 10:00 a.m. Mass.

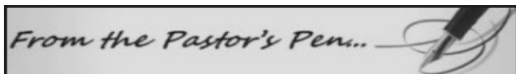
ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

At St. Mary's, we have coordinated 24 hours of Adoration seven days a week since 1953. We have an Adoration Coordinator who oversees several Adoration Captains, responsible for organizing and filling hours for different times during the week.



Dear Friends,

In the original church restoration plan, there were going to be two shortened pews at the entrance of the new narthex doors for wheelchairs. The empty spaces would be filled with four removable chairs so that people coming into the church in wheelchairs from the new entry could be placed right there in the row. It was mistakenly not executed when the pews were installed. The company came back last week and corrected this. In case you weren't able to see them at Mass last weekend, make sure to check out the new shortened pews and chairs the next time you're in the church. Please be aware next time you are choosing a seat at Mass, that these spots are reserved for ushers and those with disabilities.

A number of you have expressed concerns regarding the scratches in our beautiful new pews. I am concerned too, but I am also frustrated. Something that is in constant use by a large number of people is going to have normal wear and tear. However, some of these scratches are gouges and make me think it is carelessness or perhaps even vandalism. I have asked the pew company for their help addressing this, but I have a hard time faulting the pew company for some of these excessive scratches.

Finally, a very generous donor has gifted the parish with a new adorers' cabinet to hold the sign-in register and the library of books and other adoration accessories. It looks very nice. Thank you, anonymous donor!

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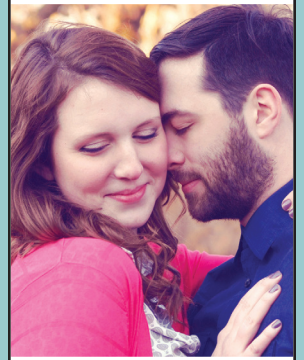
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
